



### **Contraindications / Health conditions Advice to follow before treatment**

A patch test must be performed before treatment and wait 48 hours to check for sensitivities or adverse reactions.

#### **These conditions / areas cannot be treated:**

- Pregnancy
- Pacemaker
- Heart disease
- Epilepsy
- Lupus disease
- Vitiligo
- Under 18's (parental consent required)
- Kidney Disease
- Moles (A patch will be placed on to cover)
- Anti Coagulant
- Skin phototype V and VI (dark and very dark skin)
- Cancer
- HIV/AIDS
- Keloid Scarring
- Active Tans
- Xeroderma
- Gold Injections
- Porphyria
- Haemophilia
- Diabetes
- Roaccutane

#### **Conditions to be aware of:**

- Photo sensitive medication (Patch test and wait 4 weeks)
- Semi permanent make-up and tattoos (Avoid the area)
- Skin diseases and disorders, infections, broken skin (Avoid the area)
- High or low blood pressure (Can be treated)
- Collagen, Restylane, Botox Injections (Wait 2 weeks then patch test)
- Oral Steroids (Patch test and wait 1 week)
- Implants (Avoid the area)
- Retin A (Stop using, wait 2 weeks)
- Deep peel or laser resurfacing (Wait 6 months then patch test)
- Microdermabrasion (Wait 4 weeks then patch test)
- Glycolic peels / chemical peels by doctors (40%) (Wait 1 month then patch test)
- Glycolic peels / chemical peels by salons (Wait 2 weeks then patch test)
